WEEK 2:

BOTTOM LINE:

I should trust and obey even when others don't.

WEEK 3

Abraham's Calling Genesis 12:1-5

Supporting: Genesis 13:2-18; 15:1-6

BOTTOM LINE:

I should trust and obey even if I don't know how it will all work out.

WEEK 4:

Abraham and Isaac Genesis 15, 18, 21, 22

BOTTOM LINE:

I should trust and obey even if it costs me something.







MEAL TIME

WEEK 1:

Ask a kid: Name 5 people in your life who guide and protect you.

Ask a parent: Who helped guide you when you were younger, and whom do you trust to lead you now?

WEEK 2:

Ask a kid: What are some of the rule sin your house that keep you safe?

Ask a parent: Have you ever disobeyed someone because you thought your way was better? What would you do differently next time?

WEEK 3:

Ask a kid: Sometimes in life you see other people getting away with disobeying. How does that make you feel?

Ask a parent: What are some ways you can win in real life by choosing obedience?

WEEK 4:

Ask a kid: What is something that's hard for you to obey?

Ask a parent: Talk about a time that you disobeyed and had to prove you could be trusted again.
