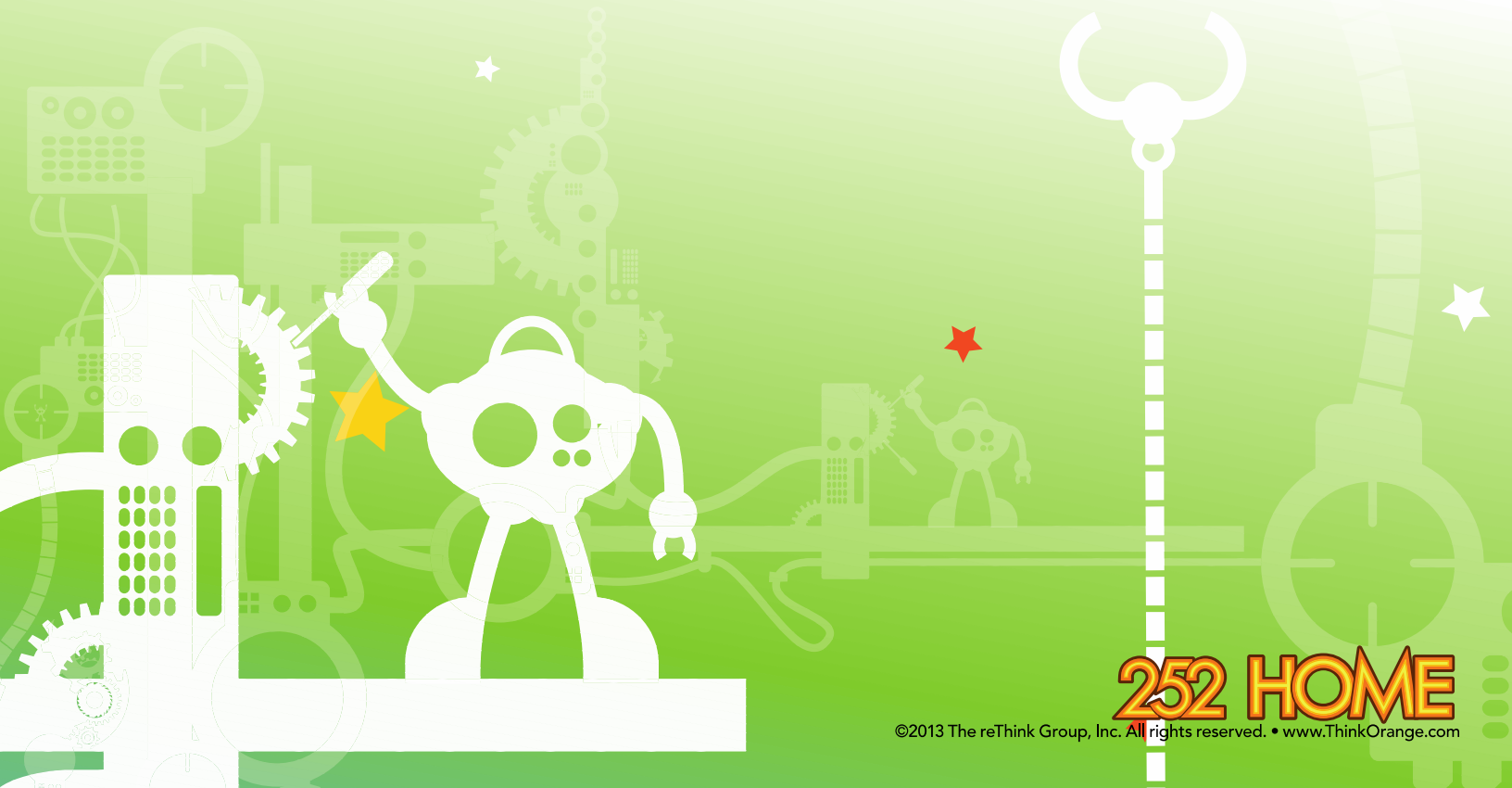
If you want to be wise, hang out with wise people.

WEEK 4:

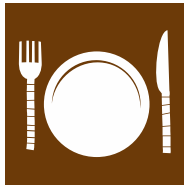

MEAL TIME

WEEK 1:

Ask a kid: Why are the choices we make in life important?

Ask a parent: How might it change your decision-making process to know that God wants to give you wisdom?

WEEK 2:

Ask a kid: How are pleasant and kind words good for you and good for those around you?

Ask a parent: Share about a time when you were “wounded” by someone’s words. What brought healing to you?

WEEK 3:

Ask a kid: Why is it important to spend time with the people you’d like to be like?

Ask a parent: When is it okay to change to fit in with the people around us?

WEEK 4:

Ask a kid: Why is it sometimes hard to think through decisions?

Ask a parent: What is something we can do to encourage ourselves to stop, think, and pray before we leap?
