Discovering what God says helps me make the wise choice.

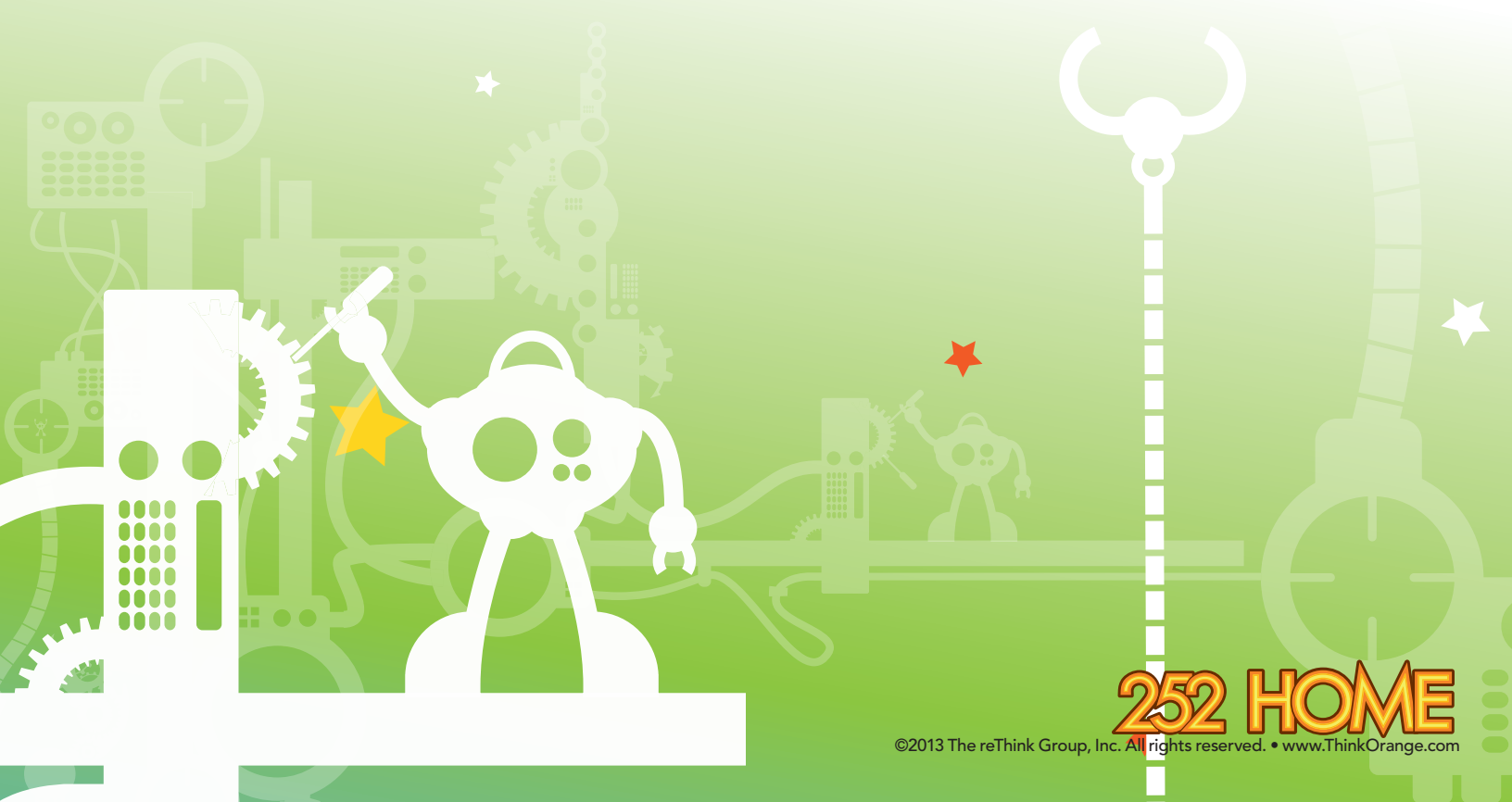
WEEK 4:

Wise and Foolish Builders

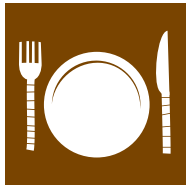
Matthew 7:24-29

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MEAL TIME

WEEK 1:

Ask a kid: What is something that you're naturally good at? Do you think you have more to learn?

Ask a parent: What are things you use to increase your knowledge of something that's important to you?

WEEK 2:

Ask a kid: Is owning a Bible enough to help you make wise choices? Why or why not?

Ask a parent: Why is it important to know what God's Word says before we face the unknown?

WEEK 3:

Ask a kid: What is your favorite activity... a sport, cooking, reading, singing? What other subjects might help you excel in your favorite activity?

Ask a parent: What school subject from your childhood do you find yourself using as an adult now?

WEEK 4:

Ask a kid: What are some of the ways that you learn from others?

Ask a parent: Why is it important to share the things we've learned in life, especially about God?
