MEAL TIME

WEEK 1:

Ask a kid: What is something you throw away every day that you could "upcycle" into something new and helpful or fun?

Ask a parent: Do you feel like you have to overcome challenges to your creativity? If so, what?

WEEK 2:

Ask a kid: Why do you think it's important to use your imagination?
Ask a parent: Sometimes when you can't solve a problem, it helps to take a "brain break" and do something creative. What is your go-to brain break?

WEEK 3:

Ask a kid: Brainstorm with your parent ways you might be able to help a sick friend.

Ask a parent: When have you been a part of a team that accomplished something together with creativity?

WEEK 4:

Ask a kid: What problem have you seen lately that you could make better with a little creativity?

Ask a parent: Why do you think God made us as creative beings?

Would you describe your son or daughter as "creative?" Maybe they like to draw, dance, or write short stories, so you'd naturally say they're creative. But if they were good at designing football plays or resolving conflicts with friends, would you still say they're creative?
